- Leading education visits for local schools and groups
- Promoting the group.

The Greenwood Community Forest Partnership works with local people to create, manage and use green spaces and parks close to where they live.

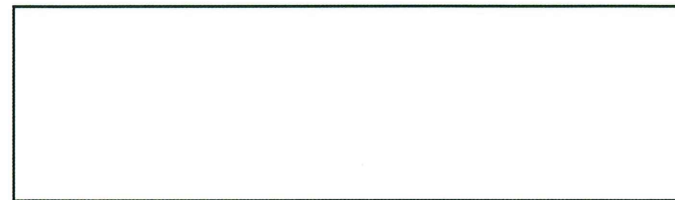
